### Agenda

1. Chairman - to elect a Chairman.

8. Open Spaces Equipment - to consider the purchase of a Glutton Electricindus 2411 Urban and Industrial Vacuum Cleaner at a cost of £16,950. The machine is electrically powered with zero CO2 emissions and vacuums up all kinds of waste with twelve hours independent operation. The silent operator means it can be used anywhere and at any time, without causing noise pollution. It comes with an anti-dust filter to ensure no dust is ejected into the atmosphere. It is easy to handle and self propelled. The Council will need to consider where this will be stored, charged, and any further actions to take regarding its operation.
9. Open Spaces Assets - to consider the purchase and citing of a bespoke bench to commemorate all the key workers of the Covid-19 pandemic.
10. CCTV - to consider the locations of additional cctv to assist in tackling fly tipping and anti social behaviour and agree actions.
