5. **Vintage Festival** - to note that Lancaster City Council has not signed off the offer letter for the agreed sum awarded to the 'Vintage Festival' application as it would rather the award be made to the 'Vintage Inspired Events Programme'. To further note that the remaining programme will now continue into the new year. The Committee is requested to approve the amendment to the application.
6. **Bare Community Association** - to note that whilst BareFest did not take place this year, the Bare Community Association would still like to receive their full grant to put towards the Christmas on the Crescent event. The Committee is requested to approve the amendment to the application.

7. **Promenade Concert Orchestra** - to note that due to Covid restrictions, the PCO has found difficulty in fulfilling all of the commitments within the application. For example, the PCO were unable to use the Winter Gardens of the Platform earlier this year and opted to have an open rehearsal for players and friends as opposed to a ticketed event. Whilst there was no May concert, the PCO's future concert dates are still due to take place (28.11.21, 30.1.22, 3.4.22, 22.5.22) and the Committee is requested to approve the amendment to the application.
