10. Recruitment - to consider and approve terms of employment for a Finance Officer.

The 2022-2023 staffing budget approved by the Council totalled £184,000.00

At its meeting of 21 July 2022, the Council approved to supplement this budget by £12,292.64 to determine any additional staffing required, noting a requirement for additional support to fulfil the Council's financial obligations.

Recommended remuneration for a Finance Officer sits within the range SCP 24 (£15.16) - 28 (£17.05) - pro rata £29,174.00-£32,798.00pa.

If a Finance Officer was onboarded in January 2023, their Q4 payroll would total pro rata £7,293.50-£8,199.50.
